



TLC High School Youth Ski Trip

Friday-Sunday, February 3-5, 2012

All High School Youth are invited for a fantastic weekend of skiing at Holiday Valley Resort in New York! We'll meet at the church at 3:30pm on Friday, load up as fast as we can and arrive in Ellicottville, NY around 9:30pm. We'll ski (or snowboard) all day Saturday and $\frac{1}{2}$ the day on Sunday, leaving in time to be back at the church around 9:30pm on Sunday night. Please see the attached "Ski Trip Details" for more information.

Cost: \$110 per person (includes lift tickets for 2 days, transportation, housing, breakfast and dinner on Saturday, breakfast on Sunday and an assortment of snacks for the weekend.) You'll need money for dinner on Friday, lunch on Saturday, and lunch and dinner on Sunday. (Rental equipment is additional.)

Registration is on a first-come basis and will be limited to 28 students. Please turn in your registration form and money to the youth office **by Wednesday, January 25, 2012**. No late registrations will be accepted. All youth must also have a current medical release / behavioral covenant on file. If you don't; grab one off the office door (or website) and turn it in with your registration form.

Weekend Schedule:

Friday:

- 3:30pm Meet at the church to load the trailer and take off
- 6pm Stop for dinner
- 9:30pm Arrive at Emmaus house, unload personal belongings and set up camp for the weekend!

Saturday

- 7:30am Breakfast at the Emmaus House
- 8:30am-4pm Ski / Snowboard (Check in between 12-1pm in the lodge)
- 5pm Worship at St. Paul Lutheran Church
- 6:30pm Dinner at the Emmaus House
- 7-9:30pm Options: Night Skiing, shopping, hanging out at house

Sunday

- 7:30am Breakfast at the Emmaus House
- 8am Load the trailer / clean up the house
- 9am-3pm Ski / Snowboard (Check in between 12-1pm in the lodge)
- 3:30pm Final pack up / head for home
- 6pm Stop for dinner
- 9:30pm Arrive at Trinity Lutheran Church and head home!

Housing: We will be staying in the Emmaus House owned by St. Paul Lutheran Church. There are some beds and couches, but some people will be sleeping on the floor! It is a little cramped, but we'll have loads of fun getting to know each other better! Rooms will be assigned before we leave so there is no "stampede" to get a good place to sleep!

Chaperones: Corinne Aebersold will be the staff member on the trip, along with 3-4 parent volunteers who have participated in this event in the past. A list of all of their cell phone numbers will be distributed to all students and parents prior to the trip.

Parent / Student Meeting: We will gather for a brief meeting on Sunday, December 18th at noon in the youth rooms. We'll answer questions, and go over the details for the meeting – and have you out by 12:30 to go each lunch!

Food:

- Friday: We will stop for dinner on Friday as we drive – you'll need money for this meal. Once we get to Ellicottville, we'll have snacks and drinks for everyone.
- Saturday: We'll make a nice breakfast at the house before sending you off to the slopes. You'll need to bring money for lunch at the lodge or one of the fast food restaurants nearby. Dinner will be served back at the Emmaus House.
- Sunday: Again, we'll do breakfast at the house before heading to the resort. You're on your own for lunch, and we'll stop for dinner on the way home – bring money for both of these meals.

Packing List: (Please make sure you label everything you bring!)

- Sleeping bag and pillow (put them in a big trash bag and put your name on it– they will be thrown in the trailer with the ski equipment and will get dirty if you don't!); Ski/snowboard equipment – if you don't have them, you can rent them...see below; Warm clothes – you'll need warm clothes for skiing, comfy yet decent clothes for the common areas of the house, as well as a nicer outfit to wear to church on Saturday night (jeans are fine, but no sweats or wind pants!); Towel and washcloth as well as all personal toiletries; Money – you'll be responsible for 4 meals (fast food or lodge lunches) as well as souvenirs, and any extra stuff you'll want to buy. We recommend at least \$40.
